#### Medical Benefit

Reimbursement subjected to the Fees Act 1951



#### Disablement Benefits

Payment rates are 80% (Temporary Disablement) and 90% (Permanent Disablement) of the daily wage from the Selected Insured Monthly Earnings with a minimum payment of RM30.00 up to a maximum of RM118.50 per day



#### Facilities for Recovery/ Rehabilitation

FREE Services Provided



#### Constant Attendance Allowance (Caregiver Allowance)

RM500 per month



#### Dependants' Benefit

- If a self-employed insured person dies as a result of self-employment injury
- Payment rate of 90% to beneficiaries



#### Funeral Benefit

A one-off payment of RM3,000
